The eradication of polio is a special priority for Rotary International, which made a commitment to immunize the world's children against polio in 1985 and became a spearheading partner in the Global Polio Eradication Initiative three years later. The other partners are the World Health Organization, the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, and UNICEF

To date, Rotary has contributed nearly \$700 million to the eradication effort, an amount that will grow to more than \$850 million by the time the world is certified polio-free.

TEDxMahtomedi is an independently organized event supported by Mahtomedi Area Community Education, Century College, and local volunteers. The TEDx event is a showcase for speakers to give their presentations on a variety of topics, and all presentations are under 18 minutes long.

The TEDx presentations are given by local community members and cover a wide range of subjects. Past speakers have discussed water conservation issues, bicycling, zombies, suicide prevention, and libraries, for example. Presenters have also given musical performances or shared artwork that they had created.

Speakers go through an extensive process before delivering their presentation at the TEDx event. Speakers must submit a proposal, audition, pass the selection process, receive coaching, and rehearse prior to their public presentation.

This year's TEDxMahtomedi event will be held on Monday, October 17 at the Dugout in Mahtomedi, and tickets will be available in September.

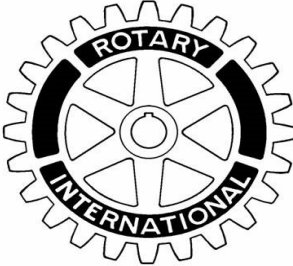
