PROGRAM. Bill Rust Presents: Deputy Alec Johnson and Luke Dohman, Explorers and Ramsey County Sheriff’s Program

Deputy Johnson introduced Luke Dohman as a member of the Ramsey County Explorer Program. Luke explained that the Explorers are administered by the Boy Scouts of America and consist of Explorers ranging from 14 to 20 years of age. There are regular meetings once a week and one Sunday per month. The time involved works out to 3 to 4 hours per week with more time for members of the Honor Guard. The Explorers program is different from Police Reserves. The program helps members to decide if law enforcement is the right career choice for young students. They participate in ride-alongs for regular car patrol or water patrol with the Ramsey County Sheriff Deputies. The Explorers also get to take part in some of the community relations events as well as Explorer competitions in which they compete with other communities in being judged on reactions to various law enforcement scenarios, pistol shooting skills, and best honor guard. Blaine and State Patrol Explorers usually win the scenario competition, Rochester and State Patrol Explorers come out on top in the pistol competition, and the Ramsey County Explorers have a reputation for winning the Honor Guard Competition. In addition to law enforcement, Explorers can participate in training for medical assistance and first aid.

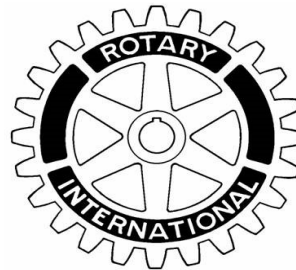

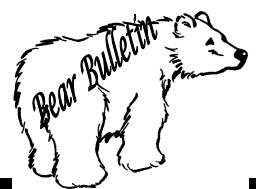
