The Lake Links Route is a safer path around White Bear Lake for children, adults, bicyclists, pedestrians and the disabled. Ramsey and Washington counties are represented and the route includes roads, trails, rough paths, and side trails along busy roads. Lake Links is an association of citizens that meet each month to get this route around the lake officially put in place. The effort is fiscally sponsored by Greater White Bear Lake Area Communities Foundation with a link to the Mahtomedi Area Green Initiative (MAGI). The purpose of getting this done is safety for bikers and pedestrians and to bring the communities around the lake closer. These communities include Mahtomedi, Dellwood, Birchwood, White Bear Lake and Township, Willernie, Century College, WB Center for the Arts, Lakeshore Players, WBL Historical Society, Greater WBL Area Community Foundation, and area churches. Lake Links wants to highlight the history of our lake and surrounding communities along the route. Parts of the route are in place (Lake Ave., Streetcar Trail) and much of the route is identified with funding and plans in place. The remaining issues include additional funding and acquisition of right-of-way. The goal for completion of the remaining work is October, 2020. 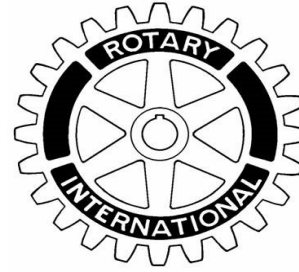

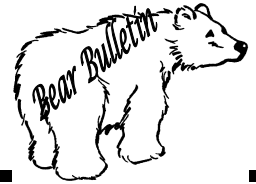
