Youth exchange students Birte and Kiho talked about their lives in their home-lands of Norway and Japan, respectively, and the impact of Rotary in their lives as their time winds down.

Birte Kamille Oen lives in Forde, Norway, which understandably is home to dramatic landscapes with mountains and a river that runs through the city of 13,000. She has two sisters and her mom and dad. Some other background: Birte had one year of high school before starting her exchange. She is quite musical, playing the guitar and piano. She also grew up performing ballet. Birte has plans for grad school and doing some sort of international work ... her Rotary experience has affirmed her love for meeting new people and seeing new places. “Many thanks,” she told Rotarians, adding that she made so many new family members.

Kiho also has a bit of a dancing background, starting with ballet and now dancing hip-hop. She loves music and sketching fashion design. Kiho has three brothers. Her father runs a cleaning company (“he is a good leader of kids,” she said). She misses her mom’s good cooking and her puppies. Some of motivations for her trip: travel, people connection, learning English and a great experience. Her Rotary sponsors in Japan thought Minnesota would be a good fit because it’s cold and there are no bugs, Kiho said. She doesn’t like bugs. She said she learned a lot of things from her host families. From the Schroeders: “A lot of smiles ... have fun” From another family: Learned that respect and honesty are vital. Learned the right words to use to show respect, as she assimilated to the U.S. but also grew personally. The other knowledge she’ll take home: -Being friendly makes life better. Students were always helpful when she first got to White Bear High School. -Think positively -Don’t judge based on experiences -It’s OK to rely on people -Stay appreciate “Thanks!” said Kiho to assembled White Bear Rotarians.

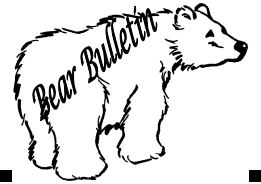
