White Bear Lake resident Mike Greenbaum is the executive director of Newtrax, a nonprofit transportation company that serves seniors and adults with disabilities in the northeast metro area.

Newtrax was formed in 2011 as a collaboration of Merrick, Inc. and PAI, Inc to more efficiently fulfill the transportation needs of each group's clientele. Newtrax has since grown to a fleet of over 50 vehicles and employs over 60 drivers.

Newtrax is known for its commitment to fulfilling senior transportation needs. They have daily loops across the north and south ends of White Bear Lake to connect senior living locations to retail shopping. White Bear Lake, Vadnais Heights, and Mahtomedi all collaborate with this initiative.

Newtrax is currently working on an automated vehicle pilot project. This pilot is likely to start in the fall of 2020.

Moving forward, Newtrax plans to grow its senior transportation segment, share its knowledge with other transportation organizations, help identify transportation gaps with local employers, and collaborate with Century College to aid in student transportation.
