### PROGRAM FROM MEETING OF 3/30/22: Yazdan Bahksh

Yazdan (Joe) was raised in the Hazara Region of Afghanistan. At the age of 15, he escaped Afghanistan, traveled to Iran, and then spent 3 ½ years in Lebanon working at an antique store in Baalbek. While in Lebanon in 1974, he was befriended by Dr. Charles Simkins and his family. Dr. Simkins was a United Nations Project Manager who lived in Minnesota. Dr. Simkins' job was to help reduce and eradicate hashish fields in the Bekaa Valley of Lebanon. The Simkins family quickly became Yazan's adoptive family. Dr. Simkins helped Yazdan get a US student visa. Once in Minnesota he attended Grace-Totino High School. Ten years later, Yazdan received his U.S. citizenship. He currently lives in North Oaks and is active in trying to get people out of Afghanistan and helping Hazara women and children. His 2012 book *You'll Be My Son Joe* is his memoir and documentary concerning his escape from Afghanistan and his many adventures in the Middle East countries, including the civil war in Lebanon, his good fortune meeting the Simkins family, and becoming a U.S. citizen. Yazdan, thank you for sharing your remarkable story and your wonderful book.
