Conrad and his wife, Mary, have lived on Bald Eagle Lake for 50 years. He and Mary have three kids (Ryan, Sally and Paul), and several grandchildren (including two Eagle Scouts).

Conrad attended South Dakota State University (SDSU) and earned a degree in mechanical engineering in 1958. Two of his grandsons attend SDSU -- one just graduated in mechanical engineering and the other is trying to find his way while playing football and lifting weights.

“I was told once you pass 80 to write everything down so you don’t forget anything,” Conrad said, referring to his notes for the classification, “but now I can’t read my writing.”

He highlighted some of his work experience. His first job was at General Mills, who was one of the largest suppliers of war materials to the US Government during the Korean War. His second job with Control Data lasted 17 years. Neither company nor division exists any longer, he noted.

The most interesting employment was working with his neighbor, Jim Muellner, at Smarte Carte. He eventually became president while the company went through three different owners. After leaving Smarte Carte, he and his son-in-law purchased Forest Product Supply, Inc. on Highway 61 and County Road C in Maplewood. The company specializes in custom wood products (cabinets, counters, etc.) and sells lumber and supplies.

**Program: Craig Drake and Jacki Reis presented Leadership Tomorrow, a program that prepares tomorrow’s leaders for today.**

Craig credited Kevin Donovan, Rita Pechmann, Bob Morse and others with getting the Greater White Bear Lake Community Foundation (GWBLCF) program underway.

The first cohort started in Jan. 2019 with 19 members and the second cohort is underway. Participants range in age from 25-57 and work in various disciplines. Leadership Tomorrow meets once a month for 10 months focusing on two tracks – leadership and community. Participants learn about their own leadership while discovering the resources and challenges in the community.

Several cohort members spoke about their experience. Matt Menier and Rotarian Amy Dauplais highlighted the many connections that have come out of this experience. Dan Perry has been impressed with the opportunity to learn about the community (arts and culture, education, services, etc.).

Jane Schneeweis commented on the connections and how nicely a mental health initiative in Mahtomedi Schools tied in with the district’s strategic planning effort.

Katie Coolie loved the holistic nature of the program. Sara Maranian highlighted the educational component. Other cohort members attending the meeting included Kelly Olson, Ryan Drake and Barb LeClure.

Steven Kelly said the program was a great entry point into the community. Mike Lovett noted that great leaders listen and asked members to think about who might be good cohort members in the future. Cohort member and Rotarian Ashley Filipovich said applications for the third cohort will begin August 1.

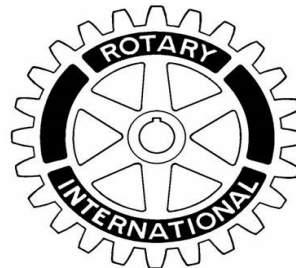
