Program: Greg Bartz presents: Russia Open World Program

In conjunction with Rotary International and the US State department our club is again hosting five Open World delegates and their group facilitator. Ours is one of six delegations from Russia or other post-Soviet bloc countries visiting this year in the US. Natalya, Oksana, Mariya, Anastasiya, and Kate (Yekaterina) are all from the Krasnoyarsk area in Siberia. All five are either educators or psychologists and the theme for this visit is special education with emphasis on music therapy.

We heard about what is important to each of the Russian delelgates. Oksana is interested in marathons, feminism, Chekov, learning English, music, dancing, biking, skateboarding, and rehabilitation for special needs children. Kate is a pre-school teacher for special needs children and works at a leading pre-school. She is a mother with a son starting school this year, loves the outdoors, sports, painting and drawing. She paints indoor or outdoor wall murals. Natalya is a daughter, sister, sportswoman, chef, and President of her area Rotaract Club. She gets entrepreneurs to speak at Rotaract meetings, raises money for various causes for the club, and is a psychologist for an energy company. Anastasiya teaches young people who want to become psychologists, likes hot Latin dancing, has a husband named Maxim, and was also involved in Rotaract. Mariya works with orphaned special needs children trying to help them live as normal a life as possible, does not have a family yet, likes travel and rock climbing. Facilitator Alina, who should be familiar to many club members, has made many trips to WBL and our Rotary meetings. She loves it here and the relationships she has made to our area. Translator, Maria Cochran has been to our meetings before too. Thanks to Greg for organizing this delegation and thanks to the host families, drivers, celebration/meal hosts, and guides from WB Rotary.

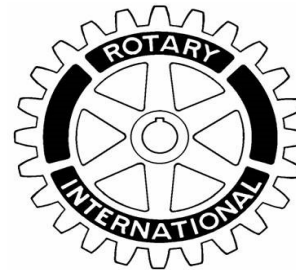
