In conjunction with Rotary International and the US State department our club is again hosting five Open World delegates and their group facilitator. Ours is one of six delegations from Russia or other post-Soviet bloc countries visiting this year in the US. Mariya works with orphaned special needs children trying to help them live as normal a life as possible, does not have a family yet, likes travel and rock climbing.
