PROGRAM: Hands -On Rotary Project - Packing Dental Hygiene Kits

to go with Thanksgiving Meals on Wheels

Community Dental Care, a non-profit 501C 3 organization serving the dental needs of the underserved in Minnesota supervised our service project of assembling dental hygiene kits (toothbrush, dental floss, and toothpaste) that will go out with the Thanksgiving Meals on Wheels. Dental disease is preventable with the right access to care. Community Dental Care has 260 employees that speak 26 languages working from four locations; East St. Paul, Maplewood, Robbinsdale, and Rochester. There is a shortage of dentists and dental care in our state. They serve 63 counties, 61% of their patients are people of color, 49% are children. They saw about 50,000 patients in 2018, most of them Medicaid recipients. Poor oral health is connected to poor overall health and the number one chronic childhood illness in America is tooth decay. Their dentists see this practice as a calling because Community Dental Care cannot pay the going market rate for their doctors. Their practice provides \$1.5 milliion in charity care each year.
