PROGRAM FROM MEETING OF 6/08/22:

Ukraine Update- Irina Fursman

The regularly scheduled program was postponed. Our own Irina Fursman graciously stepped in with an update on Ukraine and efforts being made to help the Ukrainian people. Irina presented 2 flow charts: (1) for the Immediate War Period, the emphasis is on Transit, Medical, Food, Shelter, Communication, and Dignity and (2) During the Intermediate Period the focus is on Employment, Repatriation, Shelter, Mental Health, Education, and Dignity. Because of evacuations, very small towns have swelled in population and are really struggling to provide housing and food for the evacuees. Although" big aid" is vital, Irina feels that it is helpful for small business and small projects to be established to help with immediate needs for housing, clothing and food. For example, 4 women recently formed a sewing company to make t-shirts, underwear, and socks for the troops. The Universities are using their dorms for immediate housing. Our Club is working on a District Grant to help purchase water filters. Irina stated that although there is a lot of aid going to Ukraine, in many cases it is difficult for the people to get direct access to the aid because of corruption, hording or just plain incompetence. Rotary has sent over 100 million tons of medical supplies to the Ukraine. Irina is working on establishing a 2- month leadership program in Minnesota for Ukrainian students who can obtain US visas. Irina, thank you for the excellent Program and all you do for Ukraine.
