Program: Ed Marek, Rotary District Governor

Ed Marek serves as our district 5960 governor. Ed was a member of the Shakopee Rotary Club and the Eden Prairie Rotary Club in the 1990's. He left Rotary for a short period of time due to a job change, but he rejoined the St. Paul Sunrise Club in 2001. Ed has served as club president twice and has held several different roles within the club and district.

The majority of Ed's professional career has been in nonprofit fundraising, most notably with the American Red Cross. While with the Red Cross, Ed served on several national disaster assignments throughout the state and country.

Ed discussed Rotary's response to the COVID-19 pandemic and the nation's inequality issues. Rotary's goal has been to provide a safe and inclusive environment. Rotary brings people together to solve problems, and this might be needed now more than ever. Ed also touched on the district's membership initiative and finding creative ways to start new clubs. Lastly, Ed mentioned that this has been one of the best Rotary Foundation contribution years and encouraged Rotarians to continue their support.

Classification Time: Shane Hoefer, YMCA

Shane Hoefer grew up in Arden Hills and has lived in White Bear Lake since 2010. He and his wife have 6 children and are expecting their 7th in February 2021. Shane and his family are deeply involved at St Pius Church and at Frassati Catholic Academy.

Professionally, Shane is an executive at the YMCA. He has served in various roles since he started there in 2004, and he is currently involved primarily in fundraising.

The COVID-19 pandemic has certainly affected the YMCA and altered what and how programs are offered. In March, the facilities and camps were closed per Governor Walz's orders. The YMCA therefore changed its outreach programs to help those in need. As an example, with the help of the Rotary Club and local businesses, the YMCA distributed over 46,000 meals during the summer to White Bear Lake area residents.
