- -Ken Galloway: Bear'ly Open was successful despite the cold. Estimated net proceeds of just below \$40,000, eclipsing the most recent record of \$26,000. As much as \$37,000 will go to the food shelf, allowing them to buy about \$300,000 in foodstuffs at a desperate time amid the pandemic. Ken thanked the club for the wide involvement, from sponsors to volunteers to donors. Also thanked the committee. "We had a great event," Ken said.

He has been with the Department of Natural Resources for two years, prior to covering parts of the Hutchinson area. His jurisdiction is from Forest Lake to Little Canada, White Bear Lake to Fridley.

Always wanted to be a conservation officer and enjoys interacting with kids who are excited about the outdoors. "It's always been a passion of mine," he said.

Said deer season is intense period, and then a lot of follow-up and reacting to public participation and connections. He handles calls about suspicious activity. He said his time on duty varies. He encouraged people to call even if they are uncertain about some activity they observe.

Chronic wasting disease is an area of concern. He talked about the deer feeding ban in Ramsey County. Bird-feeding still is allowed, but people need to try to keep the feeders 6 feet off the ground. The concern is that deer would congregate, and CWD appears to pass through saliva.

He said the ice angling season has been slow. He said Bellaire Beach is the biggest ice fishing community he has seen.

He said he emphasizes education in his work because the DNR fishing and game rules can be confusing or contradictory.

He said the public might be unaware of changes to bag limits on some heavily fished lakes. A sunfish change is upcoming.

In the context of education, the DNR runs courses for gun and ATV/snowmobile safety year-round. He said 97 percent of accidents happen through misuse with firearm safety. He encouraged volunteers to come forth to get trained, and then help with training.

He works with Ramsey County sheriff's office, particularly the water patrol offices. He said they can be contacted if the CO is unreachable.

He has 15 lakes to patrol, so again a need for the public to keep their eyes open to questionable activity. He will respond to calls if possible. He said people can reach him day or night at 320-583-2911, and at the least leave a message.
