Program: Wayne Kazmierczak, superintendent of White Bear Lake Schools

Wayne recently earned 'superintendent of the year' award in Minnesota schools for his and his district's hard work on multiple levels. Wayne had a good report of the school district, given the impact of the pandemic, which has driven the schools to remote learning. Some of the highlights:

- -- The school district continues to produce an outstanding number of AP scholars while offering 50 college credits last year.
- -- The graduation rate was 91.2 percent, well above the state average.
- --The district prides itself on being a good steward, and refunded a debt issue of \$1.1 million. The district is among the lowest for expenditures in the state.
- -- The district enrollment overall is lower than expected, but is expected to rise to 12,000 in the next eight to 10 years. The district serves 10 communities in the area. New housing and sales indicators point to that expanded enrollment. -- In that context, there was strong local support for the referendum, which has allowed new building and expansion plans to start. See more online at isd624.org/buildingourfuture. Ground has broken on a new gym at South Campus -- the school itself will become the new Sunrise Middle School. North and South campuses will combine at the north location, which also will undergo a big expansion that will double the size of the facility (including a fieldhouse and
