**PROGRAM: Crossing HOME, John Henderson**

Henderson founded the nonprofit, which helps men and women coming out of incarceration with housing and jobs. Henderson said the nonprofit is all about safe housing - what people need when they suddenly are back in society—and "building from square one."

Henderson knows of what he speaks: He began Crossing HOME after his own battle with addiction and a cancer fight.

He said addiction and incarceration go hand in hand. He claimed one in four people have a criminal record - a staggering number, and all because of drug and alcohol use, being under the influence.

The nonprofit current serves almost 500 people in 65 homes across Minnesota, but its reach is national, too. Tenants help pay for their rent in their homes, which have project coordinators who help people stay on track, find solid jobs, develop trust, and hold them accountable.


