PROGRAM: Bob Timmons, 2021 Taste of White Bear Lake


The Taste of White Bear Lake, our club's primary annual fundraiser, is set for Saturday, September 11, 2021, at the Pine Tree Apple Orchard. As president-elect, Bob oversees coordinating this year's event with the help of Rotarian volunteers.

The Taste of White Bear Lake started in 2011 under president Gene Altstatt. This event replaced the previous fundraising dinner and has successfully raised more and more funds each year. The money raised at this event goes towards projects like youth exchange, international grants, Boy Scout troops, Dinner with Santa, Leadership Tomorrow, vocational services, and the Lakeshore Players, for example.

For this year's Taste of White Bear Lake, there are almost 700 tickets sold and distributed, and Bob anticipates 500-600 attendees. 17 food vendors and 13 beverage vendors are committed, including a Rotary food tent for the first time. As a change from previous years, there will be no silent auction this year. Instead, Pam Bowers and others have organized a separate online auction fundraiser for November.

Bob thanks all the volunteers for making this event happen and urges Rotarians to keep selling tickets and to help out on the day of the event.
