PROGRAM FROM MEETING OF 910/5/22:

Brent Peterson, St Croix Historical Society, on Bud Fowler, black baseball icon

The St Croix Historical Society was founded in 1947, and is a 501c3 devoted to the keeping and telling of the history of the valley.

Brent Peterson gave a talk on former baseball great Bud Fowler(1859-1913), from the negro leagues. He played various positions and managed. He was elected to the Baseball Hall of Fame in 2022.

There was a league called the Northwestern League and Stillwater had a team. This was in 1884. He was an excellent player and ambassador for the game. His HOF election was long overdue, and is one of a growing number of black players to be recognized.

When in need of a field, Bud played some in WBL. He was a pioneer of blacks in the game before it was banned. He is generally known to be the only resident of Cooperstown to be in the HOF, located in Cooperstown.

Baseball was organized and played pre Civil War in the area. A professional league was formed later and the Stillwater team was in it. Articles, etc can be found at their center.
