He focused his presentation on distance learning. Greg's children range from pre-school to 4th grade. From his own experiences and those of others he knows, he offered the following perspectives:

Generally, schools have done a commendable job adapting to the new norm. It helps that kids are more tech savvy these days.

Teachers present weekly plans and assignments, and give a roadmap for the week

There is also 1:1 teacher time slots for questions from students to teachers – effectiveness can depend on prior relationship in place, and generally requires students to initiate and that may not always occur.

There is an increased burden on parents to keep kids on task and fill in gaps The kids do miss and lose the social interaction of seeing fellow youth face to face.

Community has rallied around school communities with parades, etc.

PROGRAM: Galon Miller is Chief Executive of Cyber Intelligence Cyber Security.
In addition to his for profit work, he leads a nonprofit called Cyber Warrior Foundation. He is a leader in vet transition advocacy. He spoke on computer security during this crisis.

A large % o personal and business computers have viruses and been hacked. Even if hackers are not proactively using information contained on those computers, sleeping programs are in place. He provided information on hacking:

- Description of common hacks and scams
- Hacking methods
- Uses of hacked information
- Signs or common indicators that hacking has taken place
- Steps that can be taken if your PC has been hacked.

This is a complex subject and he spoke from a PPT deck with more detail on the above items and that can be accessed by Rotarians on our site. Galon is also open to questions from Rotarians after they review and digest the information.
